

Call for

• Application deadline: November 22nd, 2024

Application

Applicants are required to:

- Submit application documents.
- Pay the application fee. (Research students only)

Screening

- Decision on whether to accept applicants (as research students, etc.) or not is made at a faculty council meeting in December.
- Decision on whether to accept applicants for the JWRI Dojo Program or not is made at a faculty council meeting in December.

Screening result • Applicants are informed of the screening result by the academic advisor via email around the end of December.

Enrollment

Successful applicants are required to:

- Acquire a Certificate of Eligibility for Status of Residence (CESR).
- •Obtain a student visa.
- Pay the enrollment fee. (Research students only)

Successful applicants are required to:

- Pay the tuition fee.
- Complete resident registration.
- Take out the National Health Insurance.
- Take out the Disaster and Accident Insurance for Student Education and Research (*Gakkensai*)

Grant money is paid.

Program participants are required to:

- Conduct research according to the research plan.
- Make a presentation on the progress of research at a presentation session or research meeting at least every three months.
- Submit a report to the academic advisor of the JWRI upon completion of the program.
